演習問題 A

1 次の文を和訳しなさい。

- (1) Most Americans feel that crime is a serious social problem, and think that violent crime is on the rise.

- (2) She was tired of arguing about whose turn it was to choose the Sunday night seven-thirty television show, of injustice, and of the monotony of everything.

- (3) Rats that live with their brothers and sisters during their early days spend a lot of time playing roughly with them.

- (4) Statistics show that the way people live determines the way they eat.

- (5) Many physical barriers associated with disabilities can be detected and corrected, but the social barriers resulting from disabilities are much deeper rooted.

- (6) *Tôfu*, a representative soybean product and originally one of the main foods in the diet of Chinese priests, is considered to be one of the healthiest foods available to man.

- (7) Indeed much of our success as human beings is based on our ability to cope with environmental changes and our tendency to seek out new and challenging experiences.

1 次の文を和訳しなさい。

- (1) People feel unreal. High-risk sports, he suggests, can, by making us face the “real experience” of death, enable us to feel alive.

- (2) It would seem that bright German or French people who have good English as well as their own language are really far better off and that the British, at any rate, are starting to realize this.

- (3) As I sit in front of my radio listening to music that is being broadcast from some far distant station, I can't help thinking of instruments called transmitters which make the waves that travel through space at a wonderful speed and bring the voices of far away musicians to my ears.

- (4) There are plenty of races at present that have fully developed languages in which they can express everything that is in their minds, but have no system of writing.

- (5) What should doctors say, for example, to a 46-year-old man coming for a routine physical checkup just before going on vacation with his family who, though he feels in perfect health, is found to have a form of cancer that will cause him to die within six months?
